Environmental and Regulatory Review Engagement Session

Territorial Planning Unit of Grand Council Treaty #3

After it's initial engagement and consultation phase, the Government of Canada has released a discussion paper to outline it's proposed approach to environmental assessments and regulatory reviews. This approach proposes a potential path for projects to proceed in partnership with Indigenous peoples and effective science-based, enforceable conditions with clear timelines.

The purpose of this session is to provide an overview of comments and expert panel reports submitted to The Government of Canada, and to continue the dialogue with Treaty #3 members on the proposed changes to Canada's environmental and regulatory framework.

This engagement session is open to two(2) Treaty #3 members per community. Chief's (or delegate) and Lands and Resource Technicians are recommended to attend.
